As a member of our South Jersey Community, I am sure you are aware of the plight of so many of our local veterans and their families. They all served our country with commitment and dedication to protect all of us and our families. But so many of them suffer hardship. In many cases, they are ignored for services they need and are entitled to get. Many suffer from PTSD and yes, we lose 22 a day nationally and about 100 a year in New Jersey to suicide. It does not have to be this way.

Our foundation created the Carlton R. Rouh Veterans Center in Lindenwold NJ to be a safe place where veterans can come for mentoring and support, get help to get the services they need and can also just enjoy spending time in a warm and vibrant place. There we provide support programs from them in Equine Therapy, Healing Arts, Photography, Gardening, Music and Culinary Arts. We have Service Agents that help them navigate the Veteran's Administration system and an attorney to help them with disability appeals. We have a "Fulfill-A-Wish" program, a Memorial Tribute program and we are developing our adjoining grassy area with a creek into a small memorial park.

As you can appreciate, it takes money to do all of this. We are a designated charitable 501(c)(3) organization and we rely on the generosity of people just like you to make all this happen.
